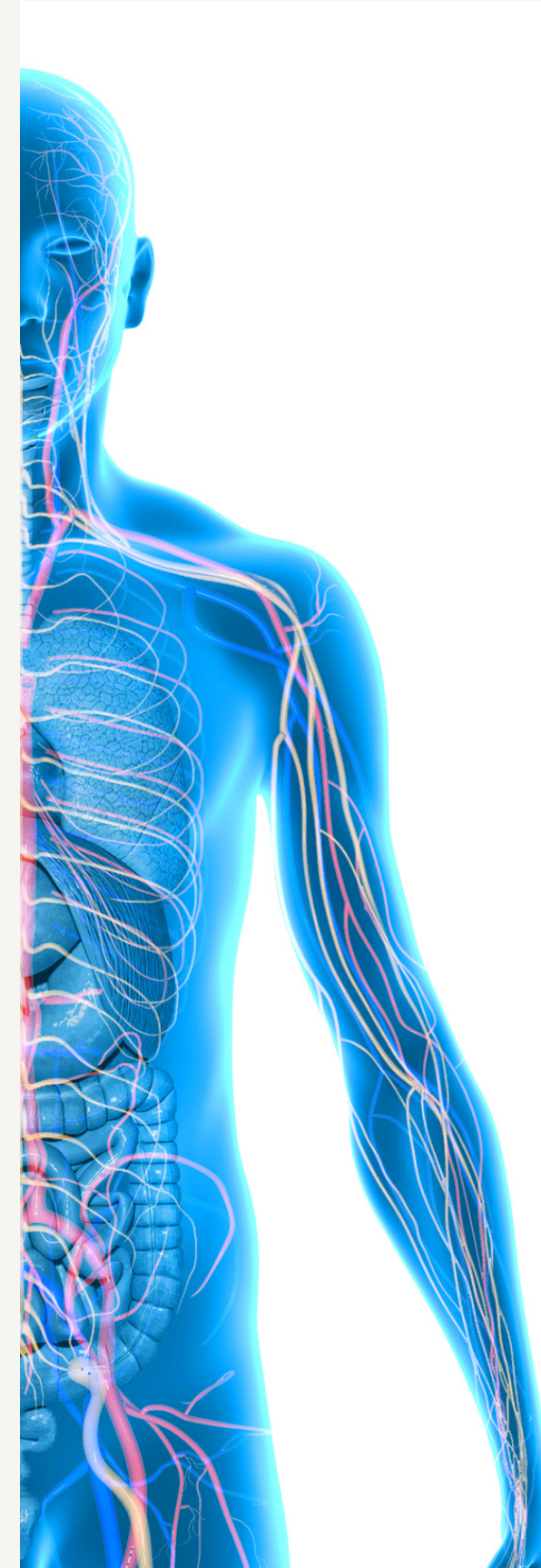

What is VHL

Von Hippel Lindau (VHL) is a genetic condition involving the abnormal growth of blood vessels in up to 10 parts of the body.

It is caused by the flaw in one gene which regulates cell growth causing patients to battle a series of tumors throughout their life.

Increased awareness of rare disease can support early and accurate diagnosis

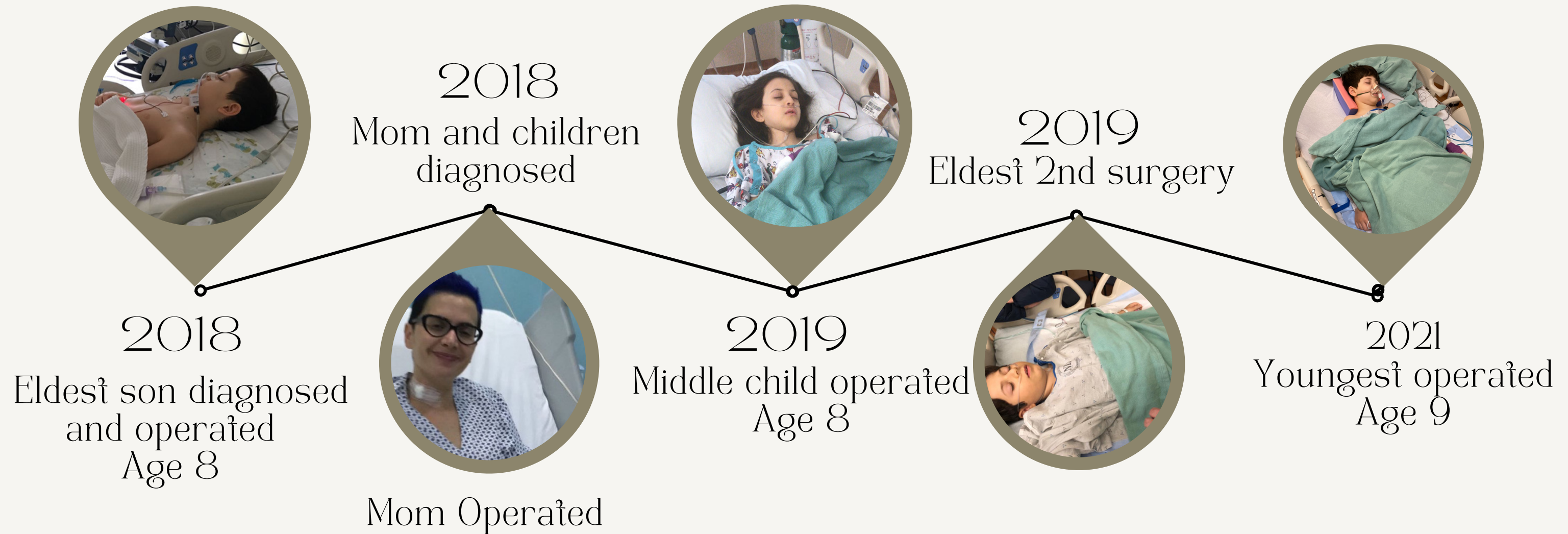
- There are between 5,000–8,000 known rare diseases
- An early and accurate diagnosis can improve the patient's quality of life as patients receive the required treatment and care for their disease
- Rare Diseases are frequently chronic with many starting in childhood
- Minimising diagnostic delays by improving genetic and rare disease recognition and appropriate specialist referrals can improve outcomes

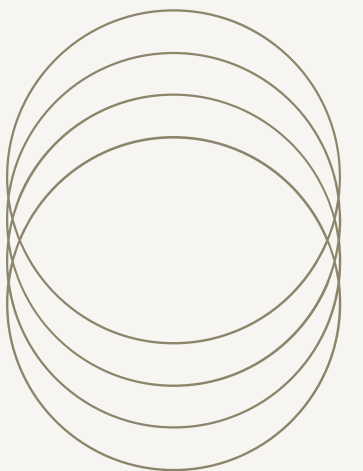


What is the NIH?
